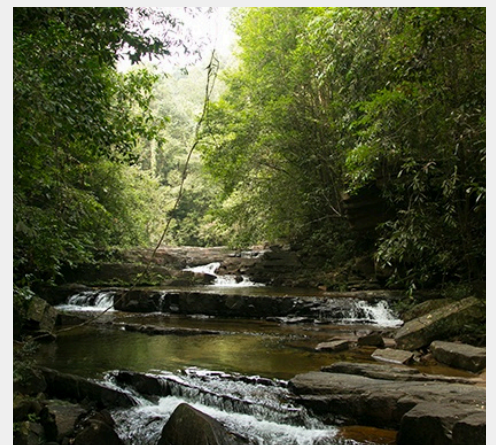
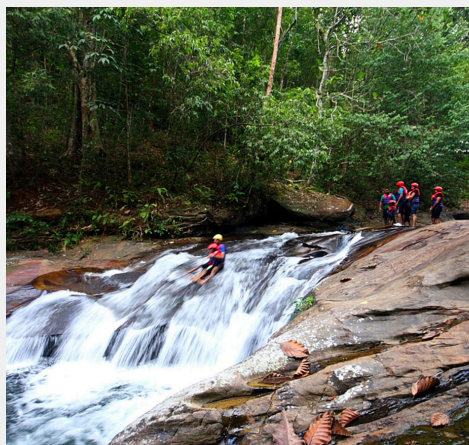


Sri Lanka Adventure & Cultural Discovery (9 Days / 8 Nights)

This itinerary combines thrilling adventures, breathtaking natural beauty, cultural insights, and opportunities for wildlife encounters, offering a comprehensive experience of Sri Lanka's diverse landscapes and rich heritage.

Day 1: Arrival & Kithulgala Adventure (1 Night)

- Morning/Afternoon: Arrive at Bandaranaike International Airport (BIA).
- Meet & Greet: Be warmly welcomed by your tour representative.
- Transfer: Scenic transfer to Kithulgala (approx. 2.5-3 hours drive).
- Afternoon: Immerse yourself in the thrill of White Water Rafting on the Kelani River (Grade 2-3 rapids).
- Late Afternoon: Enjoy Bird Watching in the lush surroundings of Kithulgala.
- Evening: Embark on a gentle Trekking excursion to explore the natural beauty.
- Optional: Visit historic Caves and embark on a Waterfall Trekking adventure.
- Accommodation: Check into your hotel in Kithulgala.
- Dinner: At the hotel.





Day 2: Sacred Peaks & Hill Country Charms (1 Night)

- Early Morning (Optional, but highly recommended): Depart from Kithulgala for Sri Pada (Adam's Peak). Begin the ascent to witness the breathtaking sunrise from the summit (2243 meters). This sacred pilgrimage site holds significance for multiple religions, believed to house the holy footprint of Lord Buddha.
 - Note: The Sri Pada climbing season typically runs from December to May. If traveling outside this period, an alternative activity or an earlier departure to Nuwara Eliya will be arranged.
- Morning: Descend from Sri Pada and have breakfast.
- Mid-Morning: Depart for Nuwara Eliya (approx. 2-3 hours drive from Sri Pada).
- En-route: Marvel at the majestic St. Clair's Falls and Devon Falls, two of Sri Lanka's most iconic waterfalls.
- Afternoon: Arrive in Nuwara Eliya, often called "Little England" due to its colonial architecture and cool climate.
- Accommodation: Check into your hotel in Nuwara Eliya.
- Evening: Enjoy the serene beauty of Lake Gregory and consider a stroll through the charming town.
- Dinner: At the hotel or a local restaurant in Nuwara Eliya





Day 3 & 4: World's End & Ella's Enigmas (2 Nights)

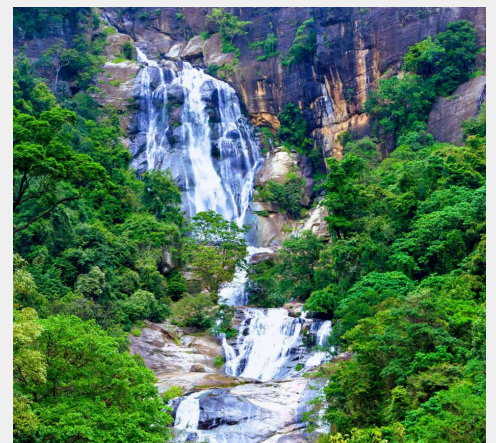
- Early Morning: Embark on an excursion to Horton Plains National Park.
- Morning: Undertake the captivating 9.5 km trail (approx. 4 hours) to World's End, a dramatic cliff offering panoramic views, and Baker's Falls.
- Late Morning: Visit Moon Plains, offering another scenic vista of the surrounding mountains.
- Afternoon: Transfer to Nuwara Eliya Railway Station.
- Afternoon: Enjoy one of the world's most scenic Train Journeys from Nanu Oya (Nuwara Eliya) to Ella. Witness verdant tea plantations, mist-shrouded mountains, and charming villages passing by.
- Late Afternoon: Arrive in Ella and transfer to your hotel.
- Accommodation: Check into your hotel in Ella.
- Dinner: At the hotel or explore Ella's vibrant main street for dining options.





Day 5: Ella's Highlights & Thrills

- Morning: Embark on a rewarding Ella Rock Tracking adventure, offering stunning views of the Ella Gap and surrounding landscapes.
- Late Morning: Hike to Mini Adam's Peak, a gentler climb providing panoramic views similar to the larger Adam's Peak.
- Afternoon: Visit the iconic Nine Arch Bridge, also known as the "Bridge in the Sky," a marvel of colonial-era engineering.
- Afternoon (Optional Thrill): Experience the exhilaration of the Flying Ravana Zip Line, Sri Lanka's first-ever mega zip line, soaring over the beautiful hills.
- Late Afternoon (For the adventurous): Explore Nil Diya Pokuna (Underwater Pond), a mystical and adventurous site believed to have been built by King Ravana. Caution and appropriate guidance are recommended for this exploration.
- Evening: Witness the majestic Ravana Waterfall.
- Dinner: At your hotel or a local restaurant in Ella.





Day 6: Ancient Temples & Wildlife Encounters (1 Night)

- Morning: Depart from Ella for Udawalawe (approx. 2-3 hours drive).
- En-route: Visit Buduruwagala, an ancient Buddhist temple complex featuring seven colossal rock-cut figures, including a massive standing Buddha statue.
- Afternoon: Arrive in Udawalawe.
- Late Afternoon: Embark on an exciting Jeep Safari in Udawalawe National Park (established 1972, 32,000 hectares). This park is renowned for its large population of elephants (approximately 450-600) and other wildlife.
- Evening: Visit the Elephant Transit Home, a fantastic experience to witness orphaned elephants being cared for and fed.
- Accommodation: Check into your hotel in Udawalawe.
- Dinner: At the hotel.

Day 7: Coastal Charms & Marine Life (1 Night)

- Morning: Depart from Udawalawe for Tangalle (approx. 1.5-2 hours drive).
- Morning: Visit a Turtle Hatchery Project along the coast, learning about conservation efforts for these magnificent creatures.
- Afternoon: Arrive in Mirissa (approx. 45 mins - 1 hour from Tangalle).
- Late Afternoon (Seasonal): Embark on a thrilling Whale and Dolphin Watching Tour from Mirissa (best season typically from November to April). Witness majestic whales and playful dolphins in their natural habitat.
- Accommodation: Check into your hotel in Mirissa or Tangalle, depending on your preference for a more active or relaxed coastal stay.
- Dinner: Enjoy fresh seafood by the beach.



Day 8



Day 8: Departure

- Morning: Depending on your flight schedule, enjoy a final Sri Lankan breakfast or some last-minute souvenir shopping.
- Transfer: Depart from Tangalle/Mirissa to Bandaranaike International Airport (CMB) for your onward flight (approx. 3-4 hours).



Important Notes:

- Package Rate: \$75 per person per day (includes transport, driver service, and daily refreshments. Accommodation and entrance fees are NOT included.)
- Accommodation is not included in the \$75 per day package rate. This package focuses on transport, driver service, and daily refreshments..
- It is recommended to check current entrance fees and activity prices closer to your travel date, as they can be subject to change by local authorities or operators.
- Accommodation: This package does NOT include accommodation. You will be responsible for booking and paying for your stays in Kithulgala, Nuwara Eliya, Ella, Udawalawe, and Tangalle/Mirissa.
- Entrance Fees: Entrance fees for attractions (e.g., National Parks, historical sites, waterfalls, zip-line) are NOT included and are generally paid directly at the site. It is highly recommended to check current entrance fees closer to your travel date as they can be subject to change.
- Optional Activities: Prices for optional activities like the Flying Ravana Mega Zip Line, whale watching, and any other activities not explicitly mentioned as included are estimates and may vary based on provider and time of year.
- Sri Pada (Adam's Peak): Please be aware of the pilgrimage season (typically December to May). If traveling outside this period, facilities might be limited. The climb is challenging and requires a good level of fitness.
- Flexibility: This itinerary is a suggestion and can be customized based on your preferences, interests, and the amount of time you wish to spend at each location. Discuss any desired changes with your driver/tour operator.
- Comfort: While transport and driver services are provided, comfort levels on journeys may vary.
- Weather: Sri Lanka has varying weather patterns across different regions. It's advisable to check the weather forecast for the specific areas you'll be visiting closer to your travel date.
- Currency: The local currency is the Sri Lankan Rupee (LKR).
- Pace: This is a moderately paced itinerary with several activities packed into each day. Adjustments can be made if you prefer a more relaxed pace.
